- There is no guarantee on the exact amount or types of produce that I will receive for my share. Weather, insects, & disease may affect the availability & quantities of produce. I will share both the risks and rewards of the growing season with the grower & the other share holders.
- It is my responsibility to pick up my share within the scheduled time & place. If it is not picked up & I have not made other arrangements, my share will be considered forfeited. non-refundable, & will be donated.
- My share contains unwashed produce and it should be cleaned before consumption.
- I have made a copy of this form for my records & am sending the signed original plus payment (or have paid by phone) to WestSide Tilth Farm.

Who we are

WestSide Tilth is an urban farm located in Buffalo, NY, owned & operated by Carrie Nader & Alex Wadsworth. We grow a variety of vegetables, microgreens, herbs, & mushrooms.

To provide the best & safest possible produce, we do not grow in the native city soil. Instead, we have imported new, clean soil which sits on top of a geo-textile barrier that does not allow potential contaminants to reach our crops.


We do not use dangerous pesticides or herbicides on our farm. Rather, we implement organic practices, crop rotation & protected culture (like high tunnels & insect netting) to mitigate disease & pest pressure.

What is a csa?

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is a mutually beneficial agreement between farmers & their community. Members purchase a share of the farm's produce in advance so farmers have operating capital. This ensures a customer base & stable income for the farmers throughout the growing season. In return, the farm provides CSA members with a weekly share of the best local produce available.

What's in a share?

Each week you will receive a collection of vegetables that are in season, around 6-8 items. The amount varies as the growing season changes, but it's generally appropriate for 2-4 people.

Some of the things you can expect in your share include seasonal salad mix, heirloom & cherry tomatoes, peppers, carrots, radishes, salad turnips, beets, cucumbers, scallions, leeks, garlic, chard, kale, mustard, spinach & fresh herbs.

The Details

Cost: One payment of \$500 due by March I Or

Two payments of \$265 due March | & April |

Payment: We accept check or money order, or payment over the phone with a credit card. Returned checks are subject to a \$30 fee. Credit card payments are subject to 3% surcharge.

First payment of \$265 due March I ensures you a membership in our share this season & is non-refundable. If the remaining balance is not paid, we will assume you forfeit your share for the season & offer it to the next person on our waiting list.

Dates: June 5 — October 30

Pick up: CSA pick up is every Tuesday from 1-7pm at the farm, 216 Normal Avenue during our regular farm stand hours. Here you can purchase extra vegetables, mushrooms, & microgreens. We accept credit cards, WIC, SNAP, & of course cash.
